We request that a new alternative be considered for the Desert Renewable Energy Conservation Plan (DRECP). The current DRECP includes no alternative that accurately reflects existing California state energy priorities that require rooftop solar and energy efficiency be fully implemented prior to developing largescale, remote solar and wind projects. The California Energy Efficiency Strategic Plan (CEESP) already exists as state law and we request it be fully implemented now.
