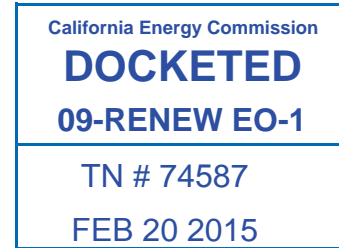

These are very precious and historic Fossil as well as Gem and Mineral sites used by the citizens of California and have been used as such for many decades.
- These sites contain fossils of petrified palm, reed, flora and ancient mud flows; along with Native American living sites and debut age.
