  - Alternatives to be analyzed in detail including selection of preferred alternative
  - Proposed Covered Species list
  - Proposed biological goals and objectives
  - Proposed monitoring and adaptive management plan
  - Proposed governance and implementation structure
  - Proposed avoidance and minimization measures for Covered Activities within DFAs
  - Proposed avoidance and minimization measures for transmission activities within and outside DFAs
